ADDITIONAL PROPERTY INFORMATION:

BRIEF HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION:

Built by Frank and Grace Lennartz; Frank Lennartz was a Geneva grocer and hardware merchant (Lennartz & Lennartz). The store was located at the southwest corner of Second and State streets, two blocks north of their residence.

Remodeling of Rear (East) Elevation was approved in 2017; Front (West) porch roof pitch raised (original low-pitched roof leaked). Work was completed in 2018.

The detached garage is not historically significant and has been heavily altered over time.

The property is significant for its association with architecture—specifically as a high-quality example of the Craftsman Bungalow style.
