BRIEF HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION:

Demolition of the previous structure (a residence) was approved in March-April of 2003; the current structure (an office building) was approved (January 2004) and constructed in 2004.

The building that previously existed on this site was a circa 1870 house L-form house with a parged foundation and clapboard walls. Windows were wood, double hung. It was described in a 1935 real estate listing as "a strictly modern 10 room house", and in further listings as a multi-unit building. Alterations were done by Clyde Stevens in 1948. The home was originally owned by Eben Conant. Additional residents include the family of Harry H. Hunter, the family of Lawrence O'Brien, Mrs. William Oatman, Dorothy Miller, the family of Harold J. Thompson, the family of Robert B. Krell, and Anna Dorothea Gass (an exchange student of the Krell family from Cologne, Germany).
